# RACHEL SULLIVAN AND NATALIA: ONE OF OUR MIRACLES TURNS 1

For so many local women, Warrenton Pregnancy Center is a Godsend that literally saves and tranforms lives.

When Rachel Sullivan discovered she was pregnant a little more than a year ago, she reached out to social services for help.

"They asked me if I had considered abortion due to my financial situation," she said. "And I couldn't find [an OB/GYN] who would see me for less than \$600 a month. And then I came across Warrenton Pregnancy Center. They gave me a list of OBs in the area that offer payment plans."

Rachel says she's grateful for the Warrenton Pregnancy Center's concern for her situation and for its faith-based guidance. She soon began seeing the doctors at Tepyac OB/GYN, a pro-life practice in Fairfax.

"WPC and Tepyac were more concerned about me than money," she said. "They definitely restored my faith in humanity. But, as much as I don't want to admit it, they restored my faith in God. With them delivering my baby, happy and healthy, they gave me everything."

Today, Natalia is a healthy 17-lb wonder, who just turned one year old. Rachel

gushes over her baby, her "miracle" and "blessing," since she had intended not to have any children of her own.

"I'm so grateful that we're in a position that I can stay home with her and only work two days a week, so I don't worry as much about missing anything new she does."

"We spent most of our days last fall walking and jogging around the park since she LOVES to be in her stroller. It's so weird that she's been here for such little time, but it feels like she's always been here."
