A full year without *Roe v. Wade*! June 24 marks the first anniversary of the U.S. Supreme Court's *Dobbs v. Jackson* ruling that ended abortion on demand in America. The decision began a new era in our defense of babies and their moms.

Thanks to you, we've nearly doubled our help to abortion-vulnerable women since last year (94 sonograms in 2022, up from 58 the year before). We're so grateful for your support, allowing us to help change the culture in Northern Virginia. Our church partners, led by remarkable pro-life pastors, have helped position the Warrenton Pregnancy Center as a front-line service in our region. Without your prayers and financial support, this would simply not be possible. Praise God for you!

MARISSA & JAMES: THE LONG ROAD AHEAD WITH A NEW BABY

Mary has been coming to us for help for a few months. Recently, she told one of her friends about the great care she was getting from the

Warrenton Pregnancy Center.

Her friend Marissa came to the Center with her boyfriend seeking pregnancy confirmation. Her urine test was positive. The nurse asked her how she was feeling about the results. She and her boyfriend, James, told us that they both identify as Christians and attend church.

The couple has been talking and working together to figure out the best course of action, though Marissa has not yet been baptized. She has had a stable but low-paying job for several years and had already set up an OB-GYN appointment.

Marissa is concerned about finances, but she and her boyfriend have been discussing ways to manage. Even before coming to us, they were working together to find solutions. James offered to ask his parents if they could move in with them. So far, Marissa has told Mary and

her mother about the pregnancy — as well as one of her work supervisors and James' sister and cousin.

On ultrasound, our nurses were unable to find the baby's heartbeat, so Marissa agreed to come back in a few weeks for another scan. Upon her return, the nurses found a strong, healthy heartbeat and everyone rejoiced for this new child of God and the baby's parents.

Marissa and James have a long road ahead of them to live in a manner pleasing to God. Our client advocates are committed to mentoring and discipling them. Please continue to pray for our work and all of our clients.
