TELLING THE TRUTH IN LOVE: HOW JANE'S STORY CHANGED US

Every client we serve at the Warrenton Pregnancy

Center has a unique story. Some stories are touching, and others are horrific.

Jane's story challenged us. She came to us in June 2023; she was pregnant but too early for an ultrasound. Jane (not her real name) received advocacy but ultimately chose a chemical abortion (abortion pill). When she returned to our clinic earlier this year, she told us that it was a *horrible* experience and that she would *never* have another abortion.

When we discussed her feelings and experiences

with the abortion more deeply, she stated that one of the primary considerations in choosing abortion (in 2023) was that she made too much money to qualify for Medicaid and didn't have health insurance. The lack of access to affordable prenatal care was self-volunteered as a significant factor in her choosing abortion.

Choosing to have an abortion is often a

multifaceted and complicated decision, but by her own confession, lack of access to prenatal care significantly skewed her in that direction. This is one factor we are addressing. We will take this reason out of the equation and possibly save many lives.

The other portion of Jane's story is that she returned to us. We told her the Truth in love about her pregnancy and the abortion procedures last year. She clearly knew our life-affirming position, and even when she found herself pregnant again this year, who did she call?

Where did she go? Back to the place that shared the Truth with her in love.

Jane is now 100% committed to carrying to term and parenting her baby. In light of this clear need, our clinic is moving forward to meet the needs of our community — both born and unborn.
