## **JENNIE'S STORY OF HOPE AND JOY DESPITE HOMELESSNESS**

The Warrenton Shelter recently contacted us about a young lady who was newly homeless,

in her third trimester of pregnancy. She had nothing and no one in her corner.

That's how we met Jennie (not her real name), a lovely 22-year-old young lady. Medically, there was nothing we could provide her since she was so far along, but we gladly welcomed her for material support and parenting education. In our interactions with her, we learned that she was already a believer.

She and the baby's father were no longer in a relationship or communicating. She was on her own, without her own family's support. She didn't have a job. She plans to study art at Germana Community

College; art is her passion.

Despite her challenging life circumstances, she has remained excited and optimistic about her

baby and being the best mother possible. Jennie has been a sponge, gratefully absorbing all the

information about the benefits of breastfeeding and parenting. She selected some courses to gain even more information about parenting.

We provided her a mommy bag, baby clothes, maternity clothes, diapers and wipes, a bassinet, an infant stroller, baby blankets, baby books, a diaper bag, baby hygiene grooming/supplies, and baby bathtub. We have also gotten her connected with governmental services and agencies.

But the most important thing we have given her is the

gift of relationship and friendship. She has few people in her life who believe in her or support her. Our personal connection is priceless for her. This was more critical to meet than all of the dire physical needs this young mother had. She has touched our hearts, and we were blessed to work with her. Jennie's son was born in January.
