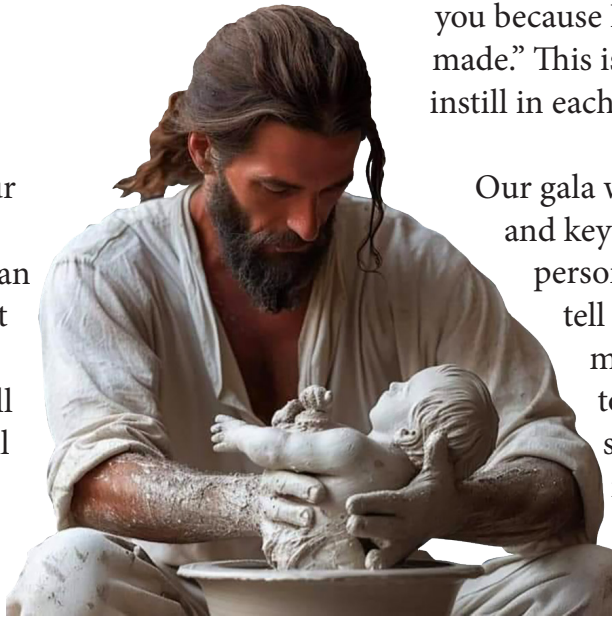

'YOU SAVED MY BABY'S LIFE' ARE WORDS WE'LL NEVER FORGET

Every baby is a miracle, but when an abortion-minded woman chooses life for her baby, even the angels in heaven rejoice. Marla (not her real name) came to us last summer. She was a U.S. Marine serving temporary duty at Quantico. She is a helicopter mechanic and a competitive shooting team member. She is separated from her husband in preparation for a divorce.

Marla conceived after "hooking up" with another military member. She was "terrified" about proceeding with her pregnancy because of the judgment of other Marines and punitive action against her by the chain of command.

When Marla met with our client advocate, a retired Army helicopter pilot and former battalion commander, her fears were eased. Our advocate prayed with her and shared that God had blessed her with this baby, affirming that this baby is not a mistake or punishment.

Marla told us that she has no religious affiliation and doesn't know how to pray. However, she is "just talking to Him, asking Him for a sign, but maybe He isn't hearing me."

We gave her a "Mom Bag" with candles, toiletries, and a Bible. When she saw the Bible, Marla gasped. "It's a sign. He hears me!"

Despite initially wanting an abortion, Marla accepted God's grace and decided to carry her baby to term. She confided her fears about the uncertainty of her path but beamed with confidence that God would deliver and provide for her. She said, "Thank you. I'm so glad I found you. You saved

my baby's life. Without you, I would have been pressured into an abortion even though I don't believe it. I was just so ashamed and scared, but you told me God loves me, and this baby isn't a mistake, or a punishment, or something to be sorry about. This baby is a blessing." That blessing will be in her mother's arms in March.
